Code of Conduct

PAVE as an organization is made up of a diverse set of stakeholders, all focused on countering violent extremism in Nigeria. It is vital that the individuals that make up PAVE uphold high standards of conduct and professionalism. Members are expected to strive to work together in order to achieve the vision of a society free from violent extremism. With this in mind members are asked to abide by the following principles.

Respect

PAVE members are to act with respect to others. Members are to show respect in all their words and actions. This includes:

- **Attentiveness** – listen to others, do not interrupt and wait your turn to speak. Side talk should be limited and phones should be kept on silent during meetings. If you have to answer your phone, please do so outside.
- **Punctuality** – members are expected to do their utmost to be on time for scheduled meetings and events and are to return promptly following breaks.

Integrity

PAVE members are expected to be ethical in all their dealings. PAVE members will strive to be trustworthy and will not tolerate dishonesty by others.

Responsibility

PAVE members will take responsibility for their actions and will accept and learn from errors. Whether committee members, general assembly members or affiliates, PAVE members are also expected to take the lead in countering violent extremism in their communities.
